How we use your personal data

UK General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR)

By joining the Society, we need to collect some items of personal data in order to provide you with your membership. This personal data we collect is: your name(s), your address, your phone number and if you provide it, your email address. We use this information for the following purposes:

You can unsubscribe from these emails at any time (via the links in emails sent via MailChimp, or by contacting us) and if you do so, the supplied personal data will be deleted from MailChimp's systems

You have a right to see the information we hold on you at any time. Contact the Secretary and we'll be happy to send you a copy of your data. We also send you a copy of your membership record once a year, when you are invited to renew your membership

You have a right to have any incorrect data we hold on you corrected. You can do this by contacting the Secretary

Finally, you have a right to request we delete any personal data we hold on you. This is also known as your right to be forgotten.
